



## What is Go4schools?

Go4schools is an online school data system which gives parents and students access to:

- **Real-time attainment information** – marks and target grades for all subjects throughout the year.
- **Timetable** – Your child’s daily and weekly timetable
- **Attendance** – Shown from the start of the academic year
- **Progress Reports** – Reports are published up to 4 times a year

After PR1 this will replace paper copies which parents have received in the past. If you are unable to access, please inform us and we will continue to provide a hard copy for you.

## How to access Go4schools

In order to log onto Go4schools you need to visit [www.go4schools.com](http://www.go4schools.com) and click on the ‘Parents’ icon in the top right hand side. Alternatively a link to Go4Schools can be found on our schools website at [www.thehazeleyacademy.com](http://www.thehazeleyacademy.com).

Enter your email address in the **First-time User?** section. This address must be the one we have on file for you. If you have changed or need to provide us with an email address please contact [data@thehazeleyacademy.com](mailto:data@thehazeleyacademy.com).

Once you have received your password from Go4schools you can login. If you have more than one child at Hazeley you can choose which to view on the next screen.

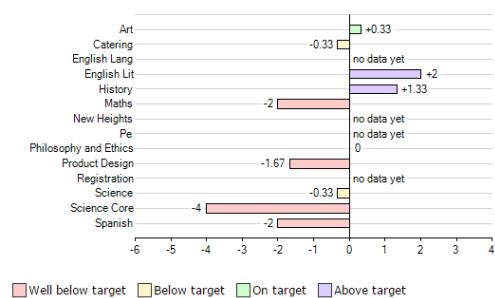

This graph shows the difference between your child’s MAG (Minimum target) and WAG (current working at grade). It is common to see a minus number on the residual graph at the start of the year due to the nature of targets.

For KS3 the target is where they should be at the end of that year. For KS4 and KS5 the target is the grade they should achieve as a minimum at the end of the Key Stage.
