What is happening?	When is it happening?
Visits to Primary Schools	<p>May 2019 Hazeley Academy staff will visit students in their primary schools to talk about what it is like to belong to the Hazeley Academy and to answer any questions they may have prior to Transition Day.</p>
Less than 5 Evening	<p>19th June 2019 For students joining Hazeley where four or fewer students are joining from their primary school.</p> <p>Our own Student Council are running an invitational social event from 4.15-5.30pm to help students make new friends.</p> <p>Running at the same time there will be an information event for parents/carers of these students.</p>
Excellence Transition day	<p>25th June 2019 Our Excellence team will invite students, identified through their work with primary schools, to an additional transition experience from 9am to 2pm.</p> <p>Students should attend in their current school uniform and are asked to bring a packed lunch and bottle of water with them.</p>
Transition Days	<p>Monday 1st and Tuesday 2nd July 2019 Students arrive at Hazeley for 8.40 am wearing their current primary school uniform and with their pencil case. Students should bring a bottle of water to drink from throughout the day.</p> <p>Lunch will be provided for students in the Academy restaurant but they may bring a packed lunch if they prefer. Students will be dismissed at 3pm.</p>
Meet the Tutor	<p>Monday 1st July 2019 (4.15pm – 6.15pm) Parents/Carers will be invited to attend a short meeting with their child's new tutor. An appointment time will be provided closer to the time.</p> <p>Also available to meet during the evening will be our KS3 Progress Leaders, Music teachers/Peripatetic lesson enrolment, Gifted & Talented Coordinator, our uniform supplier, colleagues from our Excellence department, Academy Matron and other senior members of staff.</p>
Hazeleyfest 2019	<p>Friday 12th July to Saturday 13th July An exciting event, new for this year, where the whole year group will have the opportunity to join us for games, activities, house competitions and above all fun.</p> <p>There will be the opportunity for all students to camp overnight at the Academy if they wish.</p>
New Starter Day	<p>Wednesday 4th September 2019 The first day for our new Year 7s. It is a full school day and students should arrive at the Academy by 8.35am and will finish at 3.15 pm.</p> <p>Years 8,9,10 & 11 will return on 6th September</p>
