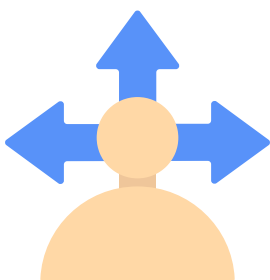
Whole School Careers in the Curriculum

We hope these presentations have allowed students to discover information regarding each role, Labour Market Information regarding salary and the demand for each role within the economy.

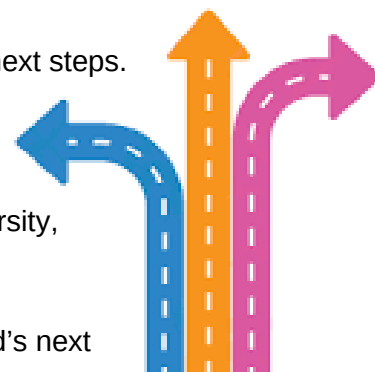
Year 11- Post-16 Pathway Planning
