When you come back in September we will be completing the Islam unit. We will also be having a more exam question focus and you will be taking an end of unit test before we move onto the Islam unit.

To help make sure that you are as prepared as possible for this, it is important that you go back over all of the **Christian Beliefs and Practices** content and create **revision resources**.

Your homework is to use the PLCs to RAG yourself (Red, Amber, Green) on how secure you feel about each part of the curriculum and complete the tasks listed below.

It is vital that you get your revision resources completed early as then this will take the pressure off at the end of Year 11.

If you are unsure about any of the content, you must let Mr Gibbins know before you go away for your summer break to get information.

Your tasks:

For **both units (Christian Beliefs and Christian Practices)** you need to:

 Create a revision resource. This could be an A3 poster, a set of flash cards, a summary PPT, detailed notes, your own mini-revision guide etc. It needs to include: key words, key concepts, the main topic headings (all of which are on your PLCs) Create an evidence sheet. This should contain key quotes and key people. Annotate them (label them) to show which topics they can link to, i.e. the quote "In the beginning God created the Heavens and the earth" can be used to show something about what God is like - that God is omnipotent as only He would have the power to do this.

Where can I find support?

Microsoft Teams contains a range of revision resources for you, including evidence sheets and support. You can also use your exercise books to develop your understanding.

You will need to bring all of the above in for your first lesson in September or upload them to the Microsoft Team so that they can be reviewed.
