PPEs & Exams 2022

I am sure you are all aware of the process for exams for GCSE and A level students this year. Those students in year 12 will have already experienced this from last year and we have a few cases where Year 10 students are also going through this process for vocational or GCSES that are being taken early. As we start to work with both year groups on Options at Post 16/18 this has no doubt got many of you thinking and considering what exams will look like for your son/daughter next year.

Exams 2022

At this current time, we have had not had direction that exams will not be happening in 2022 and therefore we will be planning to prepare all our students for a normal exam series. We are also presuming these will happen around the normal exam periods of January 2022 for Vocational units and May/June 2022 for the main exam series. Obviously if we hear any differently, we will of course let you know as soon as possible.

PPEs/UCAS Exams

Therefore, in order to ensure that our students are prepared for their final formal exams, we are continuing to run PPEs for Year 10 and 12 before the end of this academic year and our normal PPE windows have been planned for next year. This should ensure that all students are fully prepared for these exams. We will of course be considering the content of these exams, to ensure that it reflects what students have been taught this year. Teachers have already adapted their teaching plans for the remainder of this year and into next year, to ensure all content is covered in a timely manner, so that all students have the knowledge and skills to succeed in their exams and beyond.
