A few key points and dates for your diary that will help parents/carers plan ahead and know what's coming up, so you can support your child in preparing them for key events.

You will be receiving email notifications and invites to some of our events below that we are running as part of our transition arrangements.

Tuesday 28th June we are running an afterschool event 3.45 – 5.00pm for students joining us where they come from a primary school of less than 5.

Tuesday 21st June we are running an excellence (SEND) event, for students with identified SEND needs. Invite will be sent separately.

Transition day - Monday 4th July.

Some basic information as follows:

- We ask that all students arrive at **8.45am** - Students are asked to arrive at reception and we will direct you to our playground where we will register and start the day.
- Please can they wear their current primary school uniform.
- They will need to bring a packed lunch, as the canteen will not be available for students to buy food. Although students who usually have free school meals will be provided for. Please be sensitive to food allergies that other students may have.
- Students with medical needs will be expected to bring relevant medication with them.
- To avoid congestion in the car park, students will leave at 2.50pm.

During the evening parents and students will have an opportunity to have a short meeting with their form tutor, along with short presentations from Mr Nelson and Miss Gardner, Progress Leader. Our uniform provider and Academy Matron, Subject Leader for PE, Music and SENCo will also be here to help with any questions you may have.

Friday 15th July we are delighted to run Hazeleyfest 2022 – With fun activities from 5.00pm - until 8.30am Saturday morning. Students will have the option of; camping out on our school fields, sleeping in a classroom, or if they wish leave at 11pm. For your child to attend please [complete this form](#).
