# Academy Open Evening - Tuesday 28th September

We are pleased to be hosting our annual Academy Open Evening where we expect a high turn out of visitors once again. As in previous years, we are <u>closing early at 2.10pm</u> for this. This year we are putting in additional measures to reduce the volume of people involved in the evening, including less students participating, an earlier start time of 4.30pm and an additional presentation. We have reflected on our practise and will be doing a drill for this in the near future, the aim of this is to build familiarity with the process for all staff and students should the need arise. Form tutors will be delivering a session on this prior to the drill to ensure everyone is ready and clear with what their role is.

### **V2 Updates**

We wrote to you at the start of the term informing you that the council have started the consultation process and if you want to share your thoughts and comments you should click here before the end of September.

I wanted to share with you that as a school we have requested:

- Our preference would be for an additional underpass to be built allowing the safest possible safe access. Although we appreciate that this may not be a viable option due to cost
- We would encourage the speed limit to be reduced to 20mph outside of the school and 30mph on adjacent roads
- If there is no underpass built, then on the Portway side, there should also be advance warning of the Puffin crossing as this is sighted on a bend.
- In terms of project implementation, it is critical to ensure key works affecting the main access to and from the school are completed during the 6-week summer break.

Importantly as a school and local community we know that we can reduce any risks by encouraging our students to use the existing V2 underpass which leads out of the school near the canteen, directly onto the redway network.







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We also know that we can reduce traffic further by supporting and encouraging as many of our families as possible to walk or cycle using the redways and where this is not possible to use the drop off points a short distance from the Academy.
