Year Group Notices

Year 9 - PPE's

The week commencing the 23rd of May, Year 9's will be undertaking an exam week for the core subjects of Maths, English and Science. These will be run in their usual lesson time, although they will be seated in alphabetical order, so they may not be in their regular room.

We have provided the students with an exam revision guide. Included in which will be tips on revision techniques, topic lists to aid revision, and an exam timetable. Students will also receive a personalised exam timetable that we urge them to write in their planner to help assist their organisation.

There are several ways you can help your child in the build-up and during the exam period.

- Please ensure they have a dedicated workspace to help them revise.
- Limit devices late at night to ensure they are rested.
- Ensure there is a balance between relaxation and work.
- Please help them organise their stationery for the exam, including a calculator, maths equipment, ruler, pen (including spares), and pencil (including spare and sharpener).

Year 11 – The next steps

Exam timetables - all students have been given their official exam timetable. The generic timetable, for all exams, can be found here <a href="https://exams.com/here-tale-number-tale-n

Friday 13th May - Year 11 will have a normal day (form time, P1, 2, 3 and 4 until lunch). This will be an extended lunch (1:40-2:45pm) where Year 11 will be signing their shirts and taking photos. The Leaver's Assembly will take place from 2:45-3:15pm.

Monday 16th May - Thursday 23rd June — During this time, students do not attend form time, they must sign in/out via Reception. Students attend all lessons they still have an examination in (e.g., they won't need to attend PE or Art)

Q2 will be available for those students whose lessons have finished and don't wish to leave the school; this will be a silent study space. They must come prepared with resources; students will be told to leave if the study space expectations are not adhered to.

Students can either use the Canteen between 12:40-1:10pm (they swap to early lunch for the exam period), or they can go to the local shops, in between lessons, if they are free. It is critical that they sign in/out at Reception and respect our local community.

Examinations may continue until the 29th of June, should the government change the current timetable - although this is unlikely, we advise you to keep this time free.
