

The Hazeley Academy's Visual Guide for Sixth Form Dress Code

*Note that the images are examples of what is and is not permitted, styles are not limited to the images in this booklet.

What is my dress code? Smart Casual

Students in the Sixth Form are expected to wear smart clothing of their own choice. It must be clothing that would be worn in a professional or managerial environment.

Section 1: Tops

Tops including polo shirts, shirt, turtleneck, smart rugby style shirt, blouses, fitted tops.

Top must not be low cut and must completely cover cleavage and midriff. Strapped tops must have straps of at least 2inches thick.

Male students must wear a collar Smart jumpers/cardigans/ blazers are allowed Ties are optional

T-shirts are not permitted. Strapless tops, backless and thin strapped tops are not permitted. Hoodies are not permitted.

Permitted







- Any items similar or the same as these can be worn.
- Jumpers and blazers must have a form of collared top underneath them.
- Any colour can be worn providing that the item does not have massive art and logos.
- Ties are optional with any item a student










Not Permitted



- All items must be relatively plain with no eccentric logos or art designs, some minimal designs are permitted.
- T-shirts (short and long sleeve) are not permitted.
- Hoodies are not permitted.





Cleavage and strappy tops will not be tolerated within the academy.

Section 2: Trousers

Trousers should not be tight fitting and should cover the whole leg. Chino style trousers/ suit style trousers/ tailored trousers are permitted. Straight legged cargo style trousers, with minimal pockets and no logos are permitted. Leggings should only be worn under a skirt or dress.

"Any cut of trouser – wide, straight, flared – is permitted providing it fits with the rest of the guidelines." "Any colour of trouser allowed, but no bold/inappropriate/offensive logos or lettering permitted e.g. the Playboy logo, bejewelled designs and anime/cartoon print."

Jeans of any colour are not permitted. Leggings are not permitted unless under a skirt or dress

Permitted













- Suit trousers must not be skinny fit and must cover the whole leg.
- Cargo trousers must be smart no cuffs and with minimal pockets.
- All trousers, suit trousers, tailored trousers and cargo trousers must be plain colour with no big art and logos.

Not Permitted

"No excessive pockets, chains or zips."

"No tight-fitting, stretch-t-shirt material trousers or any denim"

"No rips of any kinds in any type of trouser."













- Trousers cannot be short cut.
- Trousers must not be tight fitted.
- Cargo trousers with many pockets are not allowed.
- Jeans of any colour are not allowed.
- Trousers must not have multiple eccentric colours and art designs.

Section 3: Dresses/Skirts

Dress/Skirts- If dresses or skirts are worn that are more than three inches above the knee, tights of one colour must be worn underneath them. Dresses must also not be strapless or have thin straps. Skirts that are shorter than three inches above the knee must not have a split in them.

Dresses must not be made of a tight-fitting, stretch t-shirt material or any denim.

This length skirt/dress would be deemed too short and must have single coloured tights worn with them. Mini skirts and dresses should be avoided.



Section 4: Shoes

Shoes should be smart and suitable for moving round the Academy (trainers, sandals, combat style boots and flip-flops are not acceptable)

A traditional style shoe can be of any colour.

Canvas style shoes are permitted if they are completely black (including the sole)

Section 5: Jewellery & Piercings

Piercings should be discreet, ear and nose piercings (must be hidden) are allowed, however health and safety will always be consider when making decisions on appropriate piercings, if unsure check with your progress leader first.

Eye brow piercings are not permitted.
