Dear Parents / Carers,

We have been informed this week that there are to be two additional days of strike action by the NEU this term. These will fall on Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July.

We do have a significant number of staff within this union so we will have to offer reduced face to face teaching on these dates. We have decided to rotate the year groups to make sure that across the entire disruption of strike action, each year group has as equal as possible days face to face teaching and online learning. Therefore:

Wednesday 5th July – Years 7, 9 and 12 will be in school and Year 8 will have online learning.

Friday 7th July – Years 8, 9 and 12 will be in school and Year 7 will have online learning.

Year 10 will be completing their PPE's on Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July and examinations will run as normal. If a student does not have an exam, they can study at home on both days. We will provide the study hub if students want to remain in school between two examinations.

The exams are:

5th July – AM - Design Technology.

PM - ICT.

7th July - AM – Business Studies and Psychology.

Please be aware that we have now moved sports day from Friday 7th July to Thursday 13th July so the whole school can take part.
