OPTIONS AFTER YEAR 11 – SEPTEMBER 2024 ADMISSION

Students are legally required to be in some form of recognised study or training until they are 18. Students can apply for Apprenticeships and Traineeships, for example, but couldn't go straight into a full-time job.

There are plenty of options to choose from when it comes to education and training after GCSEs and the details below provide information regarding providers in our local area.

- All applications are made directly to the individual Sixth Form, college or apprenticeship providers.
- Students who have not obtained a GCSE grade 4 pass in English Language and or Maths are required to retake these exams as they continue their post-16 education and training.

Qualification Options

GCSEs don't have to lead to A Levels. You might find that vocational qualifications offered at local colleges or T-levels are a better option because they offer a practical springboard into a career that involves hands-on learning. Colleges offer a range of courses at Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3 with Level 1 and 2 courses lasting for one year and Level 3 courses taking 2 years to complete. All T Levels are Level 3 courses.

A Levels and BTEC courses are available in all local Sixth Forms. Students typically study 3 subjects for a two-year period, and these are Level 3 courses, however, both St Pauls and Lord Grey Sixth Form's offer a small range of Level 2 BTEC courses.

Apprenticeships and Traineeships

Apprenticeships are a way to combine earning a salary, building work experience, and gaining a qualification. Apprenticeships are available at Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3.

The following table demonstrates how qualification levels link to A Levels, BTECs, T Levels and apprenticeship opportunities. Each level will have its own entry requirements which are determined by the education and training provider:

Level 1	Level 1 college courses and Level 1 apprenticeships.
Level 2	Level 2 BTECs, Level 2 college courses, GCSEs and Level 2 apprenticeships.
Level 3	Level 3 college courses, Level 3 BTECs, T-Levels and A Levels and Level 3
	apprenticeships.
