Apprenticeships are available at the following levels, each with their own entry requirements and equivalent education levels:

Level	Equivalent Educational Level
Intermediate Level 2	5 GCSE passes at Grade 4 or above
Advanced Level 3	2 A Level Passes
Higher Levels 4 and 5	Foundation degree and above
Degree Levels 6 and 7	Bachelor's or Master degree





The Apprentices spend 4 days a week in their workplace and one day a week at college or university and do not pay tuition fees for degree level qualifications.
