School Skirts:

From September 2019, students that wish to wear a skirt must wear one of our two compulsory skirts.

There are 3 different length's available via Kedaph schoolwear, to ensure that skirts adhere to the Academy's 'knee length' policy.

School Trousers:

Trousers must meet the following expectations:

- Formal trousers must be worn
- Plain black
- The trousers must be full length – must not show the calves or ankles
- We do not allow 'fashionable' trousers
- No jeans, cords, or similar fabrics
- They should not be 'skinny' or tight fitting or have a fashion belt

The images of the trousers below are intended as a guide to indicate the styles that are acceptable and those that are not acceptable.

Ties:

House ties are being introduced into our uniform. These can be purchased from our uniform supplier – Kedaph schoolwear.

- From September 2019 – All Year 7 students must wear a house tie
- **From September 2020** – Years 8 – 11 are expected to wear a new house tie

Reminder:

- Nose studs, facial or body piercings, acrylic nails and nail polish are not permitted - there will be no tolerance of these. Please bear this in mind over the summer, as we do not wish the new term to start negatively for students when it can be avoided
- False eyelashes are not permitted
- Small stud earrings are permitted
- Hair colour and style must be appropriate for the Academy. Bright colours are not permitted
- Makeup must be discreet, and nail varnish clear
