Drop off – Friday 12th July

Students should wear clothes that they are comfortable in and can safely do physical activities in. Students should be dropped off at the main student entrance, which is located to the right of the building as you enter the carpark, at 5 p.m. where staff will be ready to sign them in.

Students should bring all the following items:

- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Bottle for drinking water
- A **torch**
- Wash bag
- Clothes for sleeping in
- Change of daytime clothes
- A coat as we will be outside until 11 pm
- The Wonder book which will be given to all students during transition day.
- Medication, to be handed over in a named bag on arrival (inhalers can be kept).

Please ensure that all items are clearly named. Students must not have a mobile phone with them. We strongly discourage the bringing of other electronic and/or expensive items and please note that we do not accept any responsibility or liability for any loss or damage that might occur if they are brought on site.

Timings and activities

On arrival, students will be assigned into groups within their houses for some of the activities.

Activities will run from arrival until 11pm and there will be a break for dinner to be served at 6.30 p.m. – Dinner will be bolognese and garlic bread. There is an option of vegetarian Bolognese or Gluten free packed lunch for those with dietary requirements.

At 11 pm students will be escorted to their allocated sleeping venues, either outside to the tents or to main school building where they will be assigned a classroom which will be their sleeping area for the night. In the event of poor weather, we will move all students inside. Due to the large numbers of students we cannot guarantee all students can sleep in tents, however we try to ensure students are happy with where they are sleeping.

Students not sleeping over can be collected at **11pm** from **main reception**.
