Appendix

Public Sexual Harassment Workshop As part of their 2021 review into sexual abuse in schools and colleges, Ofsted interviewed 800 students aged 13 and above about their perceptions of sexual harassment and sexual violence in school amongst people their own age: 64% of girls and 24% of boys said unwanted touching happened 'a lot' or 'sometimes'. 80% of girls and 55% of boys felt that 'unwanted or inappropriate sexual comments' happened 'a lot' or 'sometimes'. When asked why they might not report these instances of sexual harassment, reasons given, amongst others, were that it was so commonplace that 'there's no point' in raising it or because they felt shame and embarrassment. This workshop aims to create another space, alongside the work schools are already doing, to help students understand their right to feel safe in public places by raising awareness of public sexual harassment. It also seeks to encourage students to feel a part of the solution to this issue by helping them feel confident in recognising and reporting behaviour that is unacceptable and by empowering them to be upstanders by 'calling out' and educating their friends if they see or hear disrespectful behaviour.
