



What is Go4schools?

Go4schools is an online school data system which gives parents and students access to:

- **Real-time attainment information** – marks and target grades for all subjects throughout the year.
- **Timetable** – Your child’s daily and weekly timetable
- **Attendance** – Shown from the start of the academic year
- **Progress Reports** – Reports are published throughout the year
- **Behaviour** – See behaviour events and detentions

How to access Go4schools

In order to log onto Go4schools you need to visit www.go4schools.com and click on the ‘Parents’ icon in the top right hand side.

Enter your email address in the **First-time User?** section. This address must be the one we have on file for you. If you have changed or need to provide us with an email address please contact data@thehazeleyacademy.com.

Once you have received your password from Go4schools you can login. If you have more than one child at Hazeley you can choose which to view on the next screen.

If you forget your password use the **Forgotten your Password?** section. This will email the address registered a new password.

WAG stands for working at grade. It is a combination of recent assessments.

FOG stands for forecast grade. It represents what the teachers think your child will achieve at the end of that key stage.

Attitude to learning is a score based on their standard of classwork, homework, general attitude to studies, uniform, timekeeping, equipment and behaviour.

Comments are written by the teacher to give feedback on areas to improve before the next PR. They are only written on a standard PR if the student has been forecast below their Target. One report a year will be a Main PR and will have a comment from all teachers.
