Dear Parent/Carer and Students,

Exam Results Day- Thursday 17th August 2023

Students will be able to collect their exam results in the foyer between 8am-10am on Thursday 17th August, they will also go live on Arbor at this time, so students have a choice on whether to come into school to collect them.

After 10am students will need to go to the exam office to collect their results.

Accessing the school on results day

Please be aware that the V2 will be closed, so you will not be able to access the school from this road or use the main car park. You will need to come in the entrance on Portway, which is by the Walnuts School, this will be open, and you will be able to park on the playground, but please be aware parking will be limited. You will then enter the school through the door from the playground into the foyer.

Student Support

The sixth form team will be available from 8am to 3:30pm on Thursday 17th, to support any students with the university Clearing process, university decisions as well as to support those who are progressing onto apprenticeships, work etc. The computers in the Q-zone will be available for students to check UCAS track and look at university places, however students may prefer to do this at home.

What if I want someone else to collect my results for me?

Students can give permission for results to be collect by a friend or relative on 17th, but they must email exams@thehazeleyacademy.com in advance of the 17th, naming the person who they can be released to. Without this permission the results will not be given to anyone else other than the student.
