- Kedaph offer an online service & even during this current climate are offering a pre-bookable slot so you can try sizes before you buy.
- Uniform standards:
 - Dark green blazer with Academy badge
 - House tie
 - Plain white formal shirt
 - Formal black trousers or one of the two compulsory skirt options available from Kedaph
 - Plain dark or tan tights or black or white socks
 - Shoes (plain black and no trainers)
 - A watch and one pair of stud earrings are allowed if a student wishes (no facial piercings)
 - Headscarf (if worn) should be plain white, black or dark green
 - Haircuts – appropriate style and colour
- Occasionally there may be a problem with uniform. If there is, please email the form tutor and put a note in the student's planner
- Unexplained uniform infringements are expected to be corrected within 24 hours

Routine

- The Cucina restaurant is open to students from 8.00am
- Students can enter the main building at 8:20am
- At 8:35am the outside entrances are locked & students are expected to be en route to their form rooms
- Students arriving after 8.35am should enter via reception
- Students with an unauthorised reason for arriving after 8.35am will receive a late mark and receive a 30-minute detention. *Please do ensure the form tutor is made aware of any appointments in advance to help us support your child appropriately.*
- Within the school day, each student is expected to be at their next lesson before the second bell. Once students are familiar with the building but still arrive late to lesson, they will receive a "lesson late mark" (persistently late to lessons = 30minute detention)
- Students on site after the end of the school day should be registered in an enrichment club, study club, detention or in the library – otherwise they should leave the site by 3.30pm



Homework

- Homework is given out in class
- Homework should be logged by the student in their planner for parents/carers to see
- Homework is also logged on Go4Schools – students and parents/carers will have access to this
- Manageable timescales - subjects will have a rota so students do not get issued with all their homework within the same 2 days
- We understand people make mistakes and we work with our students – please do contact your child's form tutor if you think they need support.



Rewards

When a student works hard, contributes to a lesson, or contributes within the school, they can be rewarded with:

- House Points
- Red Stamp (Going Over and Above)
- Praise Postcards
- Praise emails/phone calls home
- Celebratory gatherings or celebratory assemblies. These can also be linked to behaviour, attendance and house competitions



Detention System

We aim to work with our students in a restorative way, but sometimes consequences to poor choices are needed.

Unless you are notified directly by a member of staff, our detentions run on a next day basis.

- Next Day Detention (30 or 60 minutes).
 - Late to school or lessons
 - Homework not completed
 - Poor behaviour
 - Chewing gum
 - Mobile phones – seen or being used outside of break/lunch times
- The staff member will put a note in the planner and log the event on Go4Schools. The event will be allocated to the next day's detention & this will automatically generate an email notifying parents.



Curriculum

- We use Key Stage 2 data to group students into equal bands (A-D)
- Subjects are taught in mixed ability classes
- Maths are the only department to operate a set system within the bands
- The Creativity department operate on a rotation basis - students will cover a range of subjects within the year

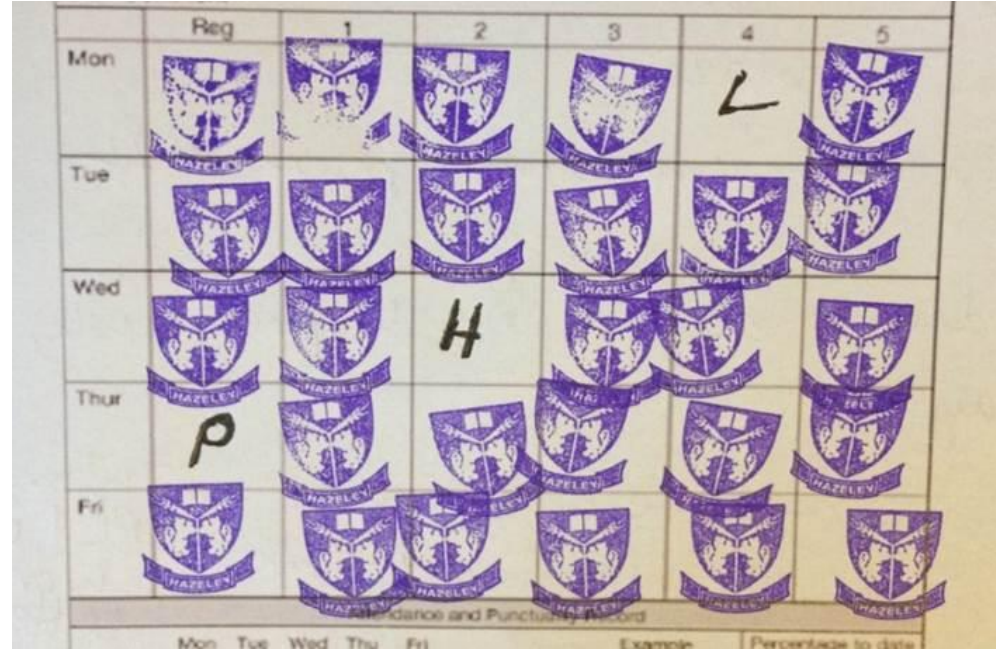

Cashless Catering

- We operate a **cashless lunch payment** system. No cash is accepted in the canteen or in the Finance Office.
- You can credit your child's account using our preferred payment method of Parent Pay (online). Our Finance Department will assist you with your log-in details in **September**.
- Parent Pay allows you to easily track your child's spending as well as offering the security of not sending your child in to school with cash.
- If you cannot access Parent Pay, cash can be deposited by your child using the automatic cash terminals located in the school's main foyer during their break and lunch period. The machines accept notes and coins (but not 1p, 2p or 5p coins).
- If a student has no money on their account, or has forgotten their lunch, then they can go to our Finance Office and they will be able to help them.
- If you have money on your primary school account, please ask for a refund as we are unable to transfer the balance .
