I hope that you and your family safe and well.

Our planning for the Transition Day itself has been made more complicated by the fact that current Department for Education guidance would mean that we would not be able to run a physical day in school. We are still working on it happening in the hope that the guidance changes to allow us to deliver the day, but I wanted to let you know that it may be necessary to cancel it. We will of course give you and your child's primary school as much notice as possible.

These will be run using the Microsoft Teams platform and your child will be set up with a login and guides circulated in June. June will also see us start our weekly communications with you.
